





Communications Committee



ATTENTION ALL MCRCC MEMBERS, WE NEED YOUR HELP!

The Electioneering Committee along with Harald (Butch) Meeks has been working hard together with many MCRCC members to create our new float for Mohave County that will be featured in main parades and other events across district 1, 2, and 3 (Bullhead, Kingman, Lake Havasu and County/Statewide). The float is designed to safely accommodate a minimum of 14 and a maximum of 22 people, including veterans, elected officials, and other community members who will proudly represent Mohave County and the State of Arizona. The float will also tow easily with surge braking making it towable from almost any tow vehicle.



We **NEED YOUR HELP** seeking the support of our County's community to spread the message of Freedom by contributing to this project. Our goal is to secure additional sponsors, starting with trailer manufacturers in the County. We need a trailer for a base to start construction of this float. The float will be constructed to travel, rated for the weight, and will include 2 or 3 axles rated for 8000 to 10000 lbs combined and surge brakes. The trailer base will measure between 26 to 30ft. School Board Committee

MCRCC SCHOOL BOARD COMMITTEE REPORT FOR July 2023

A Big welcome to our new Committee Member, Lindsay Wagner. She is a parent and her daughter just graduated from Lake Havasu City High School. Lindsay has reached out to the national organization, Mom's of Liberty. They have 100,000 members nationwide. Lindsay will share what she finds out with us. It would be great to establish a chapter of Mom's of Liberty, including Dad's, in Mohave County.

Barb Carpenter provided her report. It was interesting that most schools in Kingman have P.T.A.'s. however, only one school in Lake Havasu has a P.T.A., that is Starline Elementary. Our committee believes parental involvement is key to a strong effective educational system. Giving parents access to their child's classroom, daily curriculum assignments, reading materials, such as novels should be available to all parents.

Ed Lynch reported on the Lake Havasu City School Board. He attends the meetings, but it is rare to find any parents attending. Their next School Board Meeting is on Tuesday, July 18 at 6:00pm. Ed also shared great ideas on recruiting and vetting future School Board Candidates. All school board Candidates, in all districts, can get their packets to run from Mike File's office on January 2, 2024. We need to assist our candidates in getting the required amount of signatures necessary ,and some, to get their name on the ballot.

WHY MONITORING OUR SCHOOL BOARDS ARE IMPORTANT:

The nation's largest teacher's union, the National Education Association (NEA), has recommended that teachers read "Gender Queer" and "White Fragility" over the summer.

"Gender Queer" by Maia Kobabe and "White Fragility" by Robin DiAngelo appear on the NEA's list of "Great Summer Reads for Educators!" which was published in June.

"Gender Queer" is a graphic memoir about a young person's journey of self-discovery as they come to terms with their gender identity. It includes pornographic cartoon illustrations of sex between two males with a sex toy, as well as oral sex, masturbation, and other sexually explicit content.


"White Fragility" is a book about how white people can become more aware of their own racial privilege. It "explores why White people are so bad at talking about racism," the NEA said in a commentary published along with its recommended reading list.

MCRCC PC teams will continue to be asked to attend local School Board meetings when able. Feedback from attendance at these meetings will be crucial as we game plan to ensure Mohave County School Boards are transparent with agendas and school curriculum plans. Representative John Gillette's School Curriculum bill HB 2533. (This bill mandates that all Arizona School Districts have their lesson plans available online), passed in the House. It did not get a vote in the Senate due to missing a member. It will be held to the next Legislative session.

We verified that no Mohave County School Districts are utilizing equity-based grading systems. We will continue to monitor this as it is crucial to cease the dumbing down of our education system.

The Candidate Research Committee has been meeting regularly every 6 weeks (soon to go to every 4 week meetings) and is doing the preliminary groundwork. We have decided we will be vetting candidates for the purpose of fleshing out their views on issues, as well as having them on the record should they be elected. We will NOT be endorsing candidates, rather, we are investigating their reasons for running, their qualifications and their stances on issues and their governing philosophy. We will then turn over our work to the MCRCC and the PC's to help them in their political duties.

To this point, we are developing a questionnaire to be given to candidates for every position.

There will be 10 questions of a general nature for every candidate, and 5 questions specific to the position being sought. We have discussed a number of the questions, but we have not yet settled on the final version. We have, however, assigned the candidates each to a member of the committee for everyone who has filed a Statement of Interest with the Elections Department.

Our next meeting is July 25* @ 11:30 AM at my office at 2002 Stockton Hill Road, Suite 101.

We will keep the PC's apprised of our progress at the next Quarterly Meeting. I anticipate by that time we will have our questionnaires about ready, and there will likely be additional candidates to assign.

Effective Brainstorming

- 4. Draw a diagram.** Once you have labeled your groups, draw a diagram that shows the relationships between them.
- 5. Review the diagram.** Once you have drawn your diagram, take some time to review it and make sure that it makes sense.
- 6. Prioritize your ideas.** You may also refine your ideas by prioritizing them from good to great. This will help drive your focus to the best ideas.

Affinity diagramming is a great way to organize and categorize your ideas. It is a simple and effective technique that can be used by anyone.

Here are some tips for using affinity diagramming:

- **Encourage everyone to participate.** Affinity diagramming is a group activity, so encourage everyone to participate and share their ideas.

PREFERRED VOTING!

SIGN UP FOR EARLY VOTING!

This allows the party a chance to see if you were sent a ballot and allows for us to follow up with voters if they have not voted (we call this ballot chasing).

- To avoid potential chain of custody issues, drop your ballot in person at an early voting center or on election day.
- It is preferred to drop your ballot at an early voting center or vote in person at an early vote center and **not** mail the ballot.
- If you drop your ballot on election day, it will delay your count.
- If you must use the mail, please mail by dropping at USPS offices and **not** putting in your home mailbox to be pick up.
- If you use the mail, make certain you follow up that it was indeed received by the election office by going to: **my.arizona.vote**

Our desire is to reduce the chain of custody concerns by voting in person and voting early. If you must mail your ballot, please check to make certain it was received by the election department. By signing up for an early ballot it gives the Republican Party an opportunity to follow more voters.



VOTER REGISTRATION!

Republicans have built the largest voter registration lead in the state since 2018, we must work hard to extend that lead into 2024. Newly registered voters are 80% more likely to vote in the upcoming election cycle. Registered voters remain on the voter rolls for years to come, making it easier for GOP to track voters.

- If you have a choice, please register folks to vote on the hard copy registration forms.
- When registering with Service Arizona, the driver's license signature is all the Recorders have for signature verification. This signature is very small by the time the data reaches the Recorder's office. Sometimes it makes it very difficult to read, where the hard copy registration forms are much larger and easier for the Recorder's office to read when validating signatures.

Do not put off a registration just because you don't have a hard copy registration form. Go ahead and help them register on [ServiceArizona.com/Voter Registration](http://ServiceArizona.com/VoterRegistration), but the hard copy is preferred.


